**YOU MIGHT THINK 2020 WASN'T A GREAT YEAR.
YET...YOU WERE PART OF SOMETHING AMAZING!**

- We provided 150 Musahar families with food packages during the Covid-19 lockdown which lasted from March through to October 2020.
- We were able to start our sustainable farming initiative enabling 42 Musahar women to grow their own vegetables and fruits which will enable them to feed their families and earn a small income by selling any surplus vegetables in the market. 17 women are actively participating in the farming initiative at the moment.
- We were able to continue with our driver's training programme for 12 motivated drivers to be.
- We launched our first Pay-it-Forward campaign where our wildlife graduates and candidates in training inspired other women to become part of the 6° movement for social and economic change.
- We raised a significant amount of money during our Christmas Chicken Challenge which allows us to start our sustainable poultry farm business offering the Musahar women the possibility to run their own business, providing them with the necessary skills and better income-generating opportunities.



2020 is also the year in which we decided to change our focus on two levels: 1. focus on the marginalised Musahar communities in Chitwan only for the coming years; and 2. we changed our focus from offering vocational skills training programmes to creating sustainable jobs through business start-ups.

In 2021 we will further streamline, optimise and expand our existing projects, start the build of a sustainable eco soap factory, commence with our social empowerment and skills development programme and start the setup of an Early Child Care Development Centre (ECDC) & Community Centre. We will also intensify and further develop our partnerships with liked minded partners.

A heartfelt thank you to all our sponsors and donors for your strong support and belief in us and we look forward to 2021 and all the exciting projects that are underway or planned. We hope we can count on you so we can continue to empower more women and realise their economic and social potential.
